- ▶ Scientific merit of project, including the assessment of specific objectives, experimental design and techniques, and likelihood for success.
- ▶ Availability of internal (Research & Extension Center) and external (Project Leader) resources for project
- ▶ Significance of project to specific commodities and/or agricultural industries of the Central San Joaquin Valley. Potential benefit and transferability of information generated
- ▶ Demonstrated need to conduct project on this Research & Extension Center
- ▶ Ability of both the Research & Extension Center and the Project Leader to successfully complete project based on stated objectives
- ▶ Previous work and productive history of the Principal Investigator
- ▶ Potential for multiple users and interaction among workers from various disciplines
